

Leading Legal Software Provider Changes its Name to WINFORCE TECHNOLOGIES

*Company's Comprehensive Case Information Management System
Renamed winForce*

SCOTTSDALE, Ariz. – August 14, 2001 – A leading provider of case information management systems for both the legal and law enforcement professions has changed its name – the former Blue Knight Technology, Inc. is now winForce Technologies.

The company's top product, a comprehensive electronic case information management system formerly known as EL CID!, also has changed its name to winForce. Jimmy Wood will lead winForce Technologies into the future as its new president and chief executive officer. Wood, a co-founder of the company in April 2000, formerly served as its executive vice president and chief financial officer.

"This is an exciting day for winForce Technologies," Wood said. "Our new brand better symbolizes our core mission – to provide a comprehensive, winning solution for attorneys, legal professionals and investigators preparing a case."

Wood will replace John Stevens, the company's other co-founder and the developer of the winForce database. "The evolving success of the company has enabled John to turnover the leadership of the company to me, and to return to his first love – prosecution," said Wood.

winForce serves as an electronic index to all reports, notes, photographs, tapes and evidence gathered in the course of a case. The comprehensive legal database first gained national recognition when it was used by the Birmingham, Ala., US Attorney's Office in the successful prosecution of Thomas Blanton, Jr., a former Ku Klux Klan member accused of a 1963 Alabama church bombing that killed four young African-American girls.

The winForce software application serves as an electronic index to all the reports, notes, photographs, tapes and evidence gathered during the course of a case or investigation. winForce links all the entries to their digital images and provides the user with a focused tool array to analyze the data and organize it for trial. General features include:

- winForce tracks all information in a case – no matter what the format -- including digitized audio and video
- The database indexes and creates links for the digitized images and classifies them into categories for easy analysis and organization
- It provides a Disclosure tab allowing the user to effortlessly identify reasons why an item is not discoverable, as well as denoting reasons why an item is classified
- winForce provides comprehensive security controlling global access to the system and per-user access to each investigation with the option to limit individual access down to the field level
- It allows an unlimited number of people to work on the same case simultaneously
- winForce is the only program allowing the user to select the appropriate optimized interface: criminal or civil
- The often daunting task of creating an investigation timeline is reduced to the click of a button
- The trial notebook can be instantly produced rendering the user courtroom ready
